e.g $.25 \mathrm{~cm} \times .80 \mathrm{~cm} \times .25 \mathrm{~cm}=.050 \mathrm{~m}^{3}$

Width $\mathbf{x}$ Length $\mathbf{x}$ Height $=\mathrm{m}^{\mathbf{3}}$
e.g. $15 \mathrm{~cm} \times .60 \mathrm{~cm} \times .15 \mathrm{~cm}$
